



Sargodhian Old Boys' Association (SOBA) decided, in one of its get togethers, that dining together does not give enough meaning to life, especially when their alma mater, PAF Public School Sargodha, provided them such great education and upbringing. There was a realization that the stage in life most old boys were in, and the successful lives they were able to lead due to their school education, warrants them giving back to society what they had received. It was thus unanimously decided to setup a Trust, as the implementation vehicle, and the first objective decided was to setup a Public School (full boarding school), like their own school, in every province of the country.

With the school project running well, the Trustees upped the ante, and decided to setup Sargodhian Spirit Institute for Professional Development (SSIPD) at Rashidabad. It aims at improving the quality of teaching and learning of low-cost rural private schools of Sindh. We do it by providing state-of the-art infrastructure, engaging proficient directing staff and offering contextualized short and long term courses for 200 student- teachers at a time.

The Sargodhian Institute of Professional Development, (SSIPD) started to function on 1st July 2017, in one of the wings of the school, at Rashidabad Tando Allah Yar.

Funds have been raised and work commenced, to complete a state-of-the-art building for the SSIPD on six acres, by July 2019. SIPD is focusing on training, teachers of the low priced private schools, mushrooming in rural Sindh, and mentoring and following up on them in their schools.

PROJECT NEELAB

Having achieved targeted goal in Sind ,Trustees decided to replicate the set up of Rashidabad , which has health and vocational training facilities, in addition to education, in KP-K.125 acres of land, in the picturesque Peshawar valley has been acquired , along the Islamabad –Peshawar motorway, within 35 km of Nowshehra,Mardan and Swabi.

NEED ANALYSIS:

Need analysis of the area was done personally by Trustees, by visiting the project area, including Nowshera, Mardan and Swabi. Based on the Need Analysis, Master Planning, Conceptual Planning of projects in three sectors viz, Education , Health and Vocational training has been completed.





Operational/Business Model:

The operational model is to develop the 125 acre compound, on the Oasis concept, with residential facilities for the staff and students, sewerage, water supply, electricity, waste disposal infrastructure and ensure security; conceive and initiate the project; look for partners from amongst the best 'not for profit' organizations in the country in respective fields ;undertake fundraising; complete the project and hand it over to SST's partner organization to manage and run on a 'not for profit' mode, for the benefit of the general public.






